



18th Junior 9th Ladies Pan Arab @ El Kantaoui Golf Course 16th to 18th November 2017

Tournament Conditions

The Championship is a 54 holes Gross Stroke play tournament over 3 days.

The best 2 scores from each team will be counted every day.

The lowest total gross score over 54 holes will be crowned The Pan Arab team's champion.

The lowest individual gross score over 54 holes will be crowned The Pan Arab individual champion.

The lowest total net score over 54 holes will be crowned The Pan Arab teams' net champion. The lowest individual net score over 54 holes will be crowned The Pan Arab individual net champion.

1 / TEES

18 years & under will play from the white Tees.15 years & under will play from the blue Tees.Ladies will play from the Red Tees

2/ GENERAL

The Championship will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and the local rules of the Royal Golf Club.

The Organizing Committee will be responsible for running the Championship and reserves the right to amend the rules of play where appropriate.

3/ LOCAL RULES

A- Out of Bounds - (rule 27.1) - defined by boundary stone walls

Perimeter iron fences, white stakes, white painted kerbing or white tiles, roadways.

B- Water hazards defined by yellow stakes (rule 26.1)

Lateral water hazards are defined by red stakes.

C- Immovable obstructions (rule 24.2) - Yardage markers, All sprinkler heads and irrigation

equipment.

D- Ground Under Repair (rule 25) - includes all areas marked

By green stakes, all turf and plant nurseries and any roped off areas using yellow rope.

E- Stones in Bunkers - (rule 24.1) - are to be treated as a movable obstruction.

F- Sandy waste areas are an integral part of the golf course.

G- Slow play – Four hours is considered appropriate for 18 holes of golf. Failure to keep an appropriate pace may result in penalties as follows;

1st Offence – Warning. 2nd Offence – 1 Stroke penalty 3rd Offence – Disqualification.





4/ PACE OF PLAY:

a) The time allotted for a group to complete the 18 holes round is four and half hours. If a group is observed to be out of position, it is liable to be warned and the players individually timed by an appointed official.

b) The maximum time allowed for a shot is 40 seconds for a "first to play shot" or 30 seconds for a "second or third to play shot". If a player exceeds the time allowed on a shot he shall be deemed to have a bad time. The penalty for having a bad time as follows;

1 Bad time - Warning from Official

- 2 Bad times One stroke penalty
- 3 Bad times Two strokes penalty
- 4 Bad times Disqualification

c) The Organizing Committee may apply a penalty for undue delay (Rule 6-7) without prior warning to a group that is seriously out of position at the end of the round.

5/ PRACTI CE:

The course will be available for practice on Tuesday 14th November & Wednesday 18th, November 2017.

6/ CADDIES

1 caddy is permitted per player. Spectators are permitted with the prior permission. Caddy fee is 50 TND or \approx 25 \$ per round.

7/ MOBILE PHONES

Mobile phones are not allowed anywhere on the course and any breach of this condition may result in disqualification.

8/ CART

Each team can only use one cart. The cart can only be driven by the Head of Delegation or the Team Captain. Maximum 2 people by cart

9/ TEAM or SPECTATORS

All spectators or members of the delegation will be held at least 25 meters from the players
